It was our main focus to simplify our guidelines to make serving on the PR committee more inclusive and welcoming. I attended the PR presentation at the Celebration of Service event yesterday. Great work Bill and Ryan- thank you for your service! There were several new members in attendance that are not yet involved in service and hopefully they will take the next step to get involved!

Last Area I asked GSR's to inquire with their Home groups with regard to our 1-800 number. Hopefully we will get some feedback this month. I have also put some more thought to it as well. The primary reason we operate this line is so that no addict has to call long distance or have access to the internet to get to a meeting. It also allows the person to maintain a sense of anonymity as they do not have to speak to anyone. At the moment we have a \$143 credit on this account which will cover our bill for about another year. We also operate this line in conjunction with the PEI Region and would need to consider their input as well. I understand it is challenging to keep updated, but for now my own opinion is that we should continue to operate this line in accordance with the Purpose of this committee which states:

The Public Relations Subcommittee is a group of men and women, members of Narcotics Anonymous, who believe in the concept that "NO ADDICT SEEKING RECOVERY NEED DIE WITHOUT HAVING A CHANCE TO FIND A BETTER WAY OF LIFE". This concept should always be our primary concern.
